Race 5, late scratch, on advisement of the Official Veterinarian #1 Ernie's Martini, D. Gaskin, be scratched for being unruly in the starting gate, refund of \$26,919. Stewards' Inquiry regarding the start of #5 Where is Essa, #5 rears in the gate and turns to its right with the forelimbs getting into the #6, Bingo's Grinds stall, #6 was fortunate to have left the starting gate as the starter released the field, spoke with #6 Jockey Kirk Johnson, he stated there was no interference to him from the #5 horse or handler. #5 Where is Essa, was deemed to have received a fair start, as there was no interference to the horse and no malfunction of the gate and no refund ordered.

Inquiry video:

Race 6, All clear, spoke with Jockey Kirk Johnson regarding his ride on #4 Ginger's Holiday, Mr. Johnson stated it was his first time riding this horse and was concerned of the welfare during the stretch run.

Race 7, Turf, #9 Final Run for Love, B. Cheyne, was off slow, trailed throughout and did not finish, rest ok.
